Drug Name	Description
Azithromycin	Labeler restriction (LR) added to ophthalmic solution.
Aztreonam Lysine	LR added.
Baclofen	Additional formulation (oral suspension) added with age limit (AL).
Cabotegravir	LR added.
Estradiol Acetate	Added to the CDL with LR.
Metoprolol Succinate	LR added to extended-release (ER) capsules.
Relugolix	LR added.
Risperidone	LR added to ER injection kit.
