Enteral Nutrition Products: Prior Authorization Policy for Reject Code 75

March 1, 2022

On February 11, 2022, Prime Therapeutics State Government Solutions LLC (Prime) published a reminder alert informing stakeholders that Medi-Cal Rx has implemented a revised prior authorization (PA) policy. This policy includes Enteral Nutrition Products (ENPs).

Note: Pharmacies should not prospectively submit PAs at this time if the claim is paying.

For Reject Code 75, the PA requirement will temporarily be removed for some drugs as well as ENPs.

Specific exceptions to drugs are as follows:

- Opioid analgesics.
- Ataractics – Tranquillizers (including antipsychotics and benzodiazepines).
- Certain excluded (non-benefit) products for children under the age of 21.

Note: PAs may still be required for other reject codes such as quantity limits and Reject Code 76.
