



# How to Find Covered Drugs

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To determine drug coverage, prior authorization (PA) requirements, Code I specifics, and drug restrictions and limitations, refer to the [Medi-Cal Rx Provider Manual](#) and the [Medi-Cal Rx Contract Drugs List](#) (CDL). Use the [Drug Lookup Tool](#) (DLT) and the [Medi-Cal Rx Approved NDC List](#) to find NDC-specific drug coverage information.

## Medi-Cal Rx CDL

The [CDL](#) is a list of drugs that have been reviewed and are generally available without a PA. It is searchable by generic names only, and some drugs listed may have utilization controls referred to as a Code I restriction. Any labeler restrictions (LRs) for a drug will be notated with a five-digit LR code.

- Search for a particular drug name on the CDL by using **Ctrl + F** on the keyboard.
- Drugs that are not listed on the CDL require a PA.
- The Code I column provides diagnosis restrictions and details regarding the utilization management (UM) restrictions listed in the UM Type column such as LR, quantity limit (QL), and age limit (AL).

## Medi-Cal Rx Approved NDC List

The [Medi-Cal Rx Approved NDC List](#) is a spreadsheet that contains NDCs eligible for coverage and reimbursement under Medi-Cal Rx. The *List* is updated monthly and includes drugs listed on the CDL, as well as drugs not listed on the CDL requiring a PA. Code I restrictions for drugs listed on the CDL are not included on the *List* but can be found on the CDL.
