



Reminder: Attestation Period Ending March 31, 2022


March 24, 2022

The California Department of Health Care Services (DHCS), Pharmacy Benefits Division (PBD), requires attestation for purposes of establishing a professional dispensing fee for pharmacies participating in the Medi-Cal Rx program.

Pursuant to [California Welfare and Institutions Code, Section 14105.45](#), the professional dispensing fee is based on a pharmacy's total Medicaid and non-Medicaid annual prescription volume from the previous year as follows:

- < 90,000 claims = \$13.20 dispensing fee
- ≥ 90,000 claims = \$10.05 dispensing fee

Pharmacies with a total annual prescription volume of less than 90,000 prescriptions are required to attest to receive \$13.20 rather than \$10.05 with no exceptions. Click the link to fill out the 2021 [Pharmacy Professional Dispensing Fee Provider Self-Attestation Form](#).



- The attestation period runs from March 1, 2022 – March 31, 2022.
- Failure to attest during that period will result in the \$10.05 dispensing fee reimbursement for your pharmacy for the 2022/2023 State Fiscal Year.
