May 27, 2022

- [Reminder: Fiscal Year Two-Week Fee-for-Service Hold for Specific Provider Payments:](#) Pursuant to the published *Medi-Cal Rx Checkwrite Schedule – State Fiscal Year 2021-22*, specific payments scheduled in June and July for fiscal year (FY) 2021 – 2022 will be delayed until the start of FY 2022 – 2023.

June 1, 2022

- [Diabetic Supplies Updates:](#) Effective July 1, 2022, the *Medi-Cal Rx List of Covered Self-Monitoring Blood Glucose Systems (Glucometers), Control Solutions, and Lancing Devices* has been updated.
- [Medical Supplies Prescriber Updates:](#) California State Plan Amendment (SPA) 20-0035, effective October 1, 2020, updated the Medi-Cal prescriber requirements for medical supplies.
- [Maximum Allowable Ingredient Cost \(MAIC\) 30-Day Pharmacy Provider Notice:](#) The Maximum Allowable Ingredient Cost (MAIC) program's rates have been posted to the Mercer Medi-Cal Rx website.

- [Age Restrictions on Psychotropics Updated](#): Retroactive to January 1, 2022, all age restrictions on certain medications have been changed to reflect the Food and Drug Administration (FDA)-approved age range, and any existing pending claims that have been rejected for the age restrictions can be resubmitted for processing.

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
