## December 30, 2022

- [Bebtelovimab No Longer Authorized to Treat COVID-19](#): Effective for dates of service on or after November 30, 2022, the Department of Health Care Services (DHCS) will no longer reimburse Bebtelovimab as a pharmacy benefit.

## January 1, 2023
