

This webinar provides information specific to prior authorization (PA) requirements for beneficiaries 22 years of age and older, including submission of PAs for renewing prescriptions impacted by Phase III, Lift 4. Friday Reinstatement webinars will be available until the completion of reinstatement to provide relevant information in advance of each upcoming phase.
