## 1. Updates to the Medi-Cal Rx Contract Drugs List

The following updates have been made to the [Medi-Cal Rx Contract Drugs List](#) (CDL) and the [Medi-Cal Rx Diagnosis Crosswalk](#) \*.

Drug Name	Description
Abiraterone Acetate	Labeler restriction (LR) removed from film-coated tablets.
Bendamustine HCL	Additional LR (24338) added to the CDL.
Cyclophosphamide	LR added to vials.
Darunavir	LR removed from 600 mg and 800 mg tablets.
Diazepam	Age restriction updated for nasal spray. <b>Effective May 1, 2025:</b> Code I package size limit updated for nasal spray.
* Dupilumab	Additional diagnosis codes added to the <i>Medi-Cal Rx Diagnosis Crosswalk</i> .
Exenatide	LR removed from pre-filled injectable pens.
Loteprednol Etabonate	LR removed from 0.5% ophthalmic suspension.
Naloxone HCL	<b>Effective July 1, 2025:</b> 5 mg/0.5 ml syringe 2-pack end-dated.
Revumenib	Additional strength (25 mg) added to the CDL with LR.
Zolbetuximab-clzb	Additional strength (300 mg) added to the CDL with LR.
