Updates to the Medi-Cal Rx Web Portal Appearance and Resources: The new Department of Health Care Services (DHCS) and Medi-Cal Rx logos are now present on the Medi-Cal Rx Web Portal and select existing and all new materials.

- Changes to the Medi-Cal Rx Contract Drugs List: Changes have been made to the Medi-Cal Rx Contract Drugs List, effective November 1, 2023.
- Changes to the Medi-Cal Rx Contract Drugs List Over-the-Counter Drugs and Cough/Cold Preparations: Changes have been made to the Medi-Cal Rx Contract Drugs List – Over-the-Counter Drugs and Cough/Cold Preparations, effective November 1, 2023.
- Changes to the Medi-Cal Rx Pharmacy Reimbursable Physician Administered Drugs: Changes have been made to the Medi-Cal Rx Pharmacy Reimbursable Physician Administered Drugs, effective November 1, 2023.
- Updates to the Medi-Cal Rx Provider Manual: Updates and additions have been made to the Medi-Cal Rx Provider Manual.
- How to Resolve Reject Code A6 for Orally Administered Enteral Nutrition Claims: Effective November 10, 2023, Medi-Cal Rx will implement service codes for use by pharmacy providers when submitting enteral nutrition claims for select beneficiaries.
- Policy Update: Use of "Inner" and "Outer" NDCs for Claim Submission: The policy for submitting paper claims with "inner" and "outer" NDCs for outpatient drugs has been updated.
- 30-Day Countdown: Changes to Continuous Glucose Monitoring Systems Coverage Criteria and Prior Authorization Bundling: The prior authorization (PA) request bundling process for covered continuous glucose monitoring (CGM) systems will be effective on December 1, 2023.
