Here are the latest alerts:

January 31, 2025

- <u>Now Active Pediatric Integration for New Start Therapies and CCS Panel Authority</u>: Effective January 31, 2025, prior authorization (PA) requirements have been reinstated for new start drugs/products for members 21 years of age and younger.
- <u>Updated: Medi-Cal Rx Enteral Nutrition Prior Authorization Request Form</u>: Medi-Cal Rx recommends using an updated form when submitting PA requests for enteral products.

February 1, 2025

- <u>Updates to the Medi-Cal Rx Provider Manual</u>: Updates and additions have been made to the Medi-Cal Rx Provider Manual.
- <u>Changes to the Medi-Cal Rx Contract Drugs List</u>: Effective February 1, 2025, changes have been made to the Medi-Cal Rx Contract Drugs List.

February 5, 2025

• <u>Reminder: Populate Usual & Customary Charge Field When Submitting a Claim</u>: Medi-Cal Rx encourages pharmacy providers to populate the Usual & Customary field when submitting a pharmacy claim.

February 6, 2025

- <u>Reminder: Providers Encouraged to Sign Up for Medi-Cal Rx Electronic Remittance Advice</u>: Pharmacy providers can opt into receiving the Medi-Cal Rx remittance information via Electronic Remittance Advice (ERA) format.
- <u>State of Emergency Override Extension: Los Angeles and Ventura Counties</u>: Medi-Cal Rx is extending emergency overrides on pharmacy claims for members residing in Los Angeles and Ventura Counties.
