February 28, 2025

• Mass Adjustment for Professional Dispensing Fee Amount Increase for Impacted Claims with a Date of Service July 1, 2024, through July 25, 2024: Medi-Cal Rx initiated a mass adjustment where the correct professional dispensing fee was not considered for claims with a date of service (DOS) on or after July 1, 2024, through July 25, 2024.

March 1, 2025

- <u>Pharmacy Provider Dispensing Fee Self-Attestation</u>: The 2025 prescription volume attestation survey is now available to providers.
- <u>Maximum Allowable Ingredient Cost 30-Day Pharmacy Provider Notice</u>: Maximum Allowable Ingredient Cost (MAIC) rates will be effective April 1, 2025, and are now posted on the Mercer Medi-Cal Rx website.
- <u>Updates to the Medi-Cal Rx Provider Manual</u>: Updates and additions have been made to the Medi-Cal Rx Provider Manual.
- <u>Updates to the List of Contracted Enteral Nutrition Products, Effective April 1, 2025</u>: The List of Contracted Enteral Nutrition Products has been updated, effective April 1, 2025.
- <u>Changes to the Medi-Cal Rx Contract Drugs List</u>: Changes have been made to the Medi-Cal Rx Contract Drugs List, effective March 1, 2025.

March 3, 2025

- <u>30-Day Countdown: Medi-Cal Rx Contract Drugs List Loading Dose Quantity Policy Update</u>: Effective April 1, 2025, claims submitted to Medi-Cal Rx will deny with Reject Code 76 Plan Limitations Exceeded with special messaging if either the Code I maximum quantity per day limit or the maximum days' supply limit is exceeded for specific biologic agents.
- <u>Coming Soon: Completion of Pediatric Integration of Members 21 Years of Age and Younger</u>: Effective April 25, 2025, Medi-Cal Rx will complete implementation of claim utilization management (UM) edits and prior authorization (PA) requirements for all members, including those 21 years of age and younger, for all drugs/products.
