Formatting Error – Issue Resolved

What Pharmacy Providers Need to Know

Medi-Cal Rx has identified a formatting error on the August 8, 2025, HIPAA-compliant 835 Electronic Data Interchange (EDI) Electronic Remittance Advices (ERAs). The claim adjudication details and payment amounts included in the ERAs were not affected. The Medi-Cal Rx paper remittance advices (RAs) were not impacted by this formatting error.

This issue has been resolved, and the correction will be reflected in future ERAs, beginning with the August 15, 2025, ERAs. The August 8, 2025, ERAs will **not** be regenerated.

On the August 8, 2025, ERA, a decimal point was omitted in **Loop Segment 2110: AMT02 dollar amounts**, which may have caused confusion when reviewing.

For example, 615.00 would be displayed as 61500. Refer to *Figure 1* and *Figure 2*.

This decimal point formatting error specifically impacted:

- **Loop:** 2110 Service Payment Information
- **Segment:** AMT Service Supplemental Amount
- **Reference Designator (elements):**
 - **AMT01** – Code ZK (Federal Medicare or Medicaid Payment Mandate – Category 1)
 - **AMT02** – Submitted Gross Amount Due (GAD) dollar amount
 - **AMT01** – Code ZL (Federal Medicare or Medicaid Payment Mandate – Category 2)
 - **AMT02** – Submitted Usual and Customary (U&C) dollar amount

What Pharmacy Providers Need to Do

For the August 8, 2025, ERA, pharmacy providers are advised to imply a decimal point for the dollar amounts included in the AMT02 element for the Qualifier Code ZK (submitted GAD dollar amount) and Qualifier Code ZL (submitted U&C dollar amount).
